

RUGBY CANADA HALL OF FAME

NOMINATION FORM

Category of Nominee (please check one)

PLAYER

A nominee will be considered for selection based on playing ability, sportsmanship and character at the elite level for Canada in international competition, professionally (domestic or outside Canada) or as otherwise defined by the Rugby Canada Hall of Fame Selection Committee. A nominee will have attained a high level of excellence and brought recognition and/or honour to Rugby Union in Canada. A candidate is not eligible for nomination until five (5) years following the conclusion of active participation at the Elite level, except in the event of his or her death at which time the candidate is eligible for immediate consideration.

- On the recommendation of the members of the Hall of Fame Project Team, the CEO of Rugby Canada may grant an exception to these terms.

BUILDER

A nominee will be considered for selection on the basis of outstanding contributions at the national level as a coach, referee, manager, administrator, therapist, trainer, supporter or media person. A nominee must have furthered the growth and reputation of Rugby Union in Canada by having had influence on the game at the national and/or international level through ongoing dedication to the building of players, teams, individuals and/or rugby itself, and in doing so exemplifies the core values of rugby (as per World Rugby Core Values: Integrity – Passion – Solidarity – Discipline - Respect). A nominee must have exhibited expertise and commitment with integrity and character in at least one area of activity listed above for a minimum of ten (10) years and need not be retired from such activity to be considered.

TEAM

A team will be considered for selection on the basis of extraordinary achievements in elite senior competition in a given year, not in multiple years, and must have brought recognition and/or honour to Rugby Union in Canada at the International level. Either a Sevens (7s) team or a Fifteens (15s) team may be nominated. A team is not eligible for nomination until five (5) years after the year in which it competed, except in the case of a team winning a Gold, Silver or Bronze medal in the Rugby World Cup or in the Olympic Games, at which time the team qualifies for induction to the Hall of Fame at the next earliest opportunity.

Notes:

- Only senior teams will be considered.
- Members of the above-mentioned teams will be inducted as a team.
- A maximum of one (1) team per year may be inducted into the Hall of Fame

- Download and fully complete the Nomination Form

To help the Selection committee fully appreciate the career of the nominee, the completed Nomination Form must be accompanied by supporting materials that may include but not be limited to:

- a) A letter of endorsement from the Provincial Union
- b) A detailed and comprehensive record of data, accomplishments at the National/International level, records established, national and/or international awards, etc.

- c) Supporting materials may include scanned newspaper or magazine clippings, articles, photographs, etc.

- d) The Nomination Form and supporting written materials must be sent no later than September 30 of each year to the Secretary of Rugby Canada's Hall of Fame Project Team (Jbillingsley@rogers.com)
