



Sherry Trumbull

During her career as an international match official, Sherry Trumbull was awarded 40 international refereeing appointments in the 15s game spanning from 2009-2016. Highlights from her career include officiating at the Women's Six Nations from 2012-2016 and the Rugby World Cups in 2010 and 2014 where she took charge of the Bronze medal Final.

Sherry was regularly selected over a number of years to the World Rugby fifteens and sevens referee panels, leading to several top appointments including England versus New Zealand at Twickenham Stadium.

In addition to her time as match official for the 15s game, Trumbull was also appointed to a total of 12 international sevens tournaments including the 2013 Rugby Sevens World Cup in Moscow where she was selected for the Plate Final, followed by the World Rugby Sevens Series stop in Dubai 2013 refereeing the New Zealand v Australia Cup Final.

At the local level, Sherry officiated Canada Rugby Cup from 2011-2016, she was the first female to officiate the BC Rugby Men's Premier League Final in 2015 followed by the Rugby Ontario Men's Premier League Final in 2016.

Off the field, Sherry brought a positive level of leadership to all the officiating teams she has worked with. Time spent mentoring and supporting other match officials led to her selection as the Head Official for the 2017 Youth Commonwealth Games, where she led officials from six different countries.
