POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Women and Girls Rugby Project Coordinator will cultivate girls' rugby through the active delivery of the girl's rugby program in schools, clubs, and the community. The Women and Girls Rugby Project Coordinator will work with the Rugby Development Manager to build resources for a girls' rugby program to be implemented across the country through the national Rugby Development Officer network. The Women and Girls Rugby Project Coordinator will ensure that there is visibility of girls' rugby at targeted national events through activations and other promotions.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- In partnership with targeted member provincial unions support schools, clubs and community organizations in the development and delivery of girls rugby
- Deliver blocks of girls' rugby in elementary schools and high schools
- Develop girls' rugby program resources for national implementation
- Coordinate implementation of a girls' rugby program through the national rugby development officer network supported by the Rugby Development Manager
- Coordinate equipment and clothing for a girls' rugby program
- Coordinate activations at national events (i.e. women's 15s half time activations)
- Source good news stories which amplify girls' rugby and collaborate with the Rugby Canada marketing department supported by the Rugby Development Manager
- Report on delivery objectives for commercial partners and key stakeholders as required
- Other duties may be assigned as required (i.e. deliver HSBC Rookie Rugby or HSBC Rugby Counts)
