- Communication with other therapists, doctors, S&C, sport science and coaching staff to ensure effective short and long term Return to Play programs are implemented for the athletes
- Supporting all Rugby Canada program's IST in developing athletes with winning mentalities and professional habits
- Maintain comprehensive injury records through charting, collecting and posting all relevant information on Rugby Canada's EMR
- Assist in the maintenance of clinic equipment and supplies
- Various duties around clinic including inventory, cleaning, laundry and other nontherapy related tasks.
- Work with team manager and insurance coordinator with processing insurance claims
- Local, domestic and international travel may be required at times, and as needed depending on the calendar of events
- Student instruction- The Pacific Pride program at Rugby Canada takes Athletic Therapy students every semester and an ideal candidate would feel comfortable with teaching and overseeing students while they are on placements.
