Rugby Canada (RC) is the national sport organization committed to the domestic development and international success of Rugby for Canada.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Rugby Canada is seeking a Head Coach, National U20W who will be involved in creating and supporting a successful team environment, based on elite level coaching skills and processes, for the National U20W.

The appointed person will lead the U20W program and work with the program staff, the NSW15s Head Coach, the Manager, National Women's Program.

OBJECTIVE

The assigned person will perform the role of Head Coach of the National U20W. The role will be viewed as being an integral and significant element of the high performance player pathway process as outlined in Rugby Canada's *Long Term Rugby Development* framework.

The Head Coach, National U20W will lead the team in the preparation for the 2018 U20W 3-game series versus England U20W (August 2018) and will be involved in developing a successful team environment during the selection and preparation stages as well as in the series itself.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES AND PRIORITIES

The Head Coach, National U20W will be responsible for performing the following roles and/or delivering the following outcomes.

- Coaching, Team Preparation & Performance
- Player Development
- Reporting

The appointed individual must be able to display an ability to work during periods of extended hours including weekends and evenings. A valid driver's license and passport is essential.

Applicants are to submit the names of three potential individuals who can report on the specified selection criteria. At least two of these individuals must be able to comment in detail upon the applicant's involvement in coaching and in particular be in a position to comment upon the applicant's understanding of contemporary expectations of coaches as program managers and people managers.

The selection emphasis will be based upon the applicant's knowledge, skills and attributes to drive the culture of the U20 Women's high performance program into the future.
