POSITION DESCRIPTION

Age Grade coaches will be responsible for supporting the outcomes for the U18 and U20 programs during the 2018/19 season. Successful applicants will be geographically assigned for selection camps. Staff selection for NA4 competition will be decided by Rugby Canada not later than November 1st.

- b. Develop well-structured training sessions, as requested, in the areas of:
 - Run/Catch/Pass
 - Contact Area
 - Defense
 - Set Piece
 - Attack and/or Defence

4. Player Development & Appraisal

- a. Monitor and assess individual player performance and development using available resources.
- b. Provide regular performance and development review feedback, as well as a final assessment upon completion of the program to each player and Rugby Canada.
